

2007 BAM Meeting Minutes

February 11, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 12:00 PM by Bobby Kline.

Attendance was low, only 10 members were present.

- 1) The definition of “presented” for weigh in was confirmed. Presented means the fish are placed in the tub for weigh in, not the bag as previously mentioned. When the fish are placed in the tub they become property of the club and are subject to the tournament rules and the Tournament Director.

- 2) The dates for the second two day tournament have been confirmed.
 - a. 9/8 Long Lake
 - b. 9/9 Grand Lake

- 3) We will be staying at Northwood Shores Resort on Grand Lake on Friday September 7th and Saturday, September 8th. There are six cabins and plenty of space for the club. Check out their web site at northwoodshoresresort.com.

The fact that we are new to this resort requires a \$480 deposit to reserve it for that weekend. Gary Olsen will determine with the resort on how the deposit will be handled. If all 23 members attend it works out to about \$48 per man, or \$24 per night.

To cover the cost, have your share of the deposit to Gary by May 1st. Each member has to cover \$20 towards the deposit. The total amount now due to Gary by May 1st is.

\$200 to cover all tournament costs
\$ 20 for deposit.

If you pay the deposit and do not make the trip due to a hardship issue, the club will reimburse you.

For those who want to stay Sunday night it is only \$20 per man for the night.

- 4) It was mentioned in the previous minutes that Craig volunteered to be the pass by boat for all tournaments to determine if each member is on time for the weigh in. Now he claims that he didn't volunteer to do that (I kept good notes, he did in fact

volunteer). None the less, the club officers will make the ruling while the Tournament Director is on shore preparing for the weigh in.

- 5) There were several options presented on how the Classic should be set up. It was voted on and there are no changes to the current format. The top ten in total points after all eight tournaments make the classic. The lake selection process will be determined by those ten. There will still be a 3-2-1 payout. Big Bass is a side bet set up by the 10 qualifiers.
- 6) The teams for the first team tournament will be drawn at the Friday meeting at Intermediate, the same as previous years.

A suggestion was raised about a seeding process for the second team tournament. Prior to the second team tournament to be fished on Maceday, the first place member would be teamed up with last place, second place with second to last, and so on. We decided that a club vote would take place at the Intermediate meeting to determine if we pick members out of a hat or do it by seeding.
